## Dear Administrator Zeldin:

We are alarmed by your decision to dismantle the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Office of Research and Development (ORD), the cornerstone of scientific policymaking at the Agency. ORD research informed the implementation of the Safe Drinking Water Act and the Clean Air Act, ensuring that the air Americans breathe and the water they drink are safe and free from dangerous pollutants. Without ORD, EPA will be unable to fulfill its mission to protect human health and the environment.

Since its founding in 1970, the EPA has had an independent research arm that has ensured policy decisions are based on sound, unbiased scientific research. ORD studies water pollution, drinking water pollutants, toxic chemicals, smog, climate change, air contaminants, wildfire, and more. The office conducts this research at ten facilities across the country, located in Rhode Island, New Jersey, Ohio, the District of Colombia, North Carolina, Georgia, Florida, Oklahoma, Minnesota, and Oregon. This geographic diversity is critical to studying environmental challenges unique to different parts of the country and supporting regional research ecosystems.

Since January, approximately one-fifth of ORD employees have accepted early retirement.<sup>2</sup> Closing ORD through additional Reductions in Force and reassignments of ORD staff will deprive the Agency of the skilled workforce needed to ensure policies are grounded in the latest science. Gutting EPA's scientific brain trust will delay the development of new standards needed to protect the health and well-being of Americans. Additionally, the brain drain will hamper EPA's ability to understand and respond to future environmental risks.

Furthermore, shuttering ORD and moving the majority of EPA's scientific work into policy offices will open the door to political interference in EPA decision-making, undermining the effectiveness of EPA policies and undermining public trust in the EPA. The current structure of ORD insulates scientific work from policymaking to prevent undue influence. Transitioning EPA's scientific work into program offices will create opportunities for political interference, resulting in policies that fail to protect Americans and the environment.

Your mission to abandon unbiased science, slash EPA's workforce, and gut critical environmental protections does nothing to protect the health and safety of Americans and their environment. It will allow corporations to pollute with impunity as Americans get sicker. With this in mind, we request answers to the following questions.

What is your justification for closing ORD?

- 2. What is the timeline for the closure of ORD? When will the new Office of Applied Science and Environmental Solutions open? What is the plan to ensure critical research continues uninterrupted during this transition?
- 3. Will existing ORD labs continue to operate under the new Office of Applied Science and Environmental Solutions? Will staffing levels at ORD labs remain the same?
- 4. How many ORD employees have been assigned new positions within EPA? How many ORD employees have accepted these new positions?
- 5. How many ORD employees will receive Reduction in Force notices?
- 6. What is your plan to ensure research conducted by EPA employees is conducted without political interference?

We ask that you respond to these questions no later than August 21, 2025, and urge you to allow ORD to continue its vital work. The health of millions of Americans and well-being of our environment depend on it.
